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


Data import from Excel

You can import data from a Microsoft Excel file into SAP Business One.

Beware:

- Texts must not contain line breaks
- If prices are imported via article import, the ME code column must contain a value.
- Microsoft Excel files must be saved and imported as TXT files, the encoding of the TXT file must be ANSI



- TXT files must be closed before importing
- TXT files may only contain data to be imported and no header line nor blank lines!
- For the time of the data import, the numbering series for items / business partners must allow the manual numbering method (Administration > System initialization > Document Numbering > Items / Business Partners Customer / Business Partners Vendor)
- The number of characters in the cells of the Microsoft Excel table must not exceed the <u>length</u> of the corresponding field in SAP Business One, information on the data type can be found in the data import templates https://business-one-consulting.com/wp-content/uploads/2021/03/conesprit Template-for-data-import-from-Excel-1.xlsx


Please test the data import in a test database before you import the data into your productive database!

- 2. Save the Excel file as TXT, delete the title lines and make sure that the TXT file does not contain any blank lines
- 3. Under Administration > Data Import/Export > Data Import > Import from Excel > File type for import: select **Business Partner**
- 4. Select the TXT file







Create Bill of Materials list by copying from Excel






Carry out data import in a test system. If the import in the test system has been successful, the import can be carried out in the productive system.

- Call up parts list in add mode
- Select assembly
- Copy parts list composition from Excel file
- 4. Place the input pointer in the first line of the parts list in the No. field, right-click "insert"
- The composition of the parts list from Excel is inserted into the parts
- Select Control and Add
